



Our headline 2022 SATs results for Key Stage 2 were:-

- In writing 65 % of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 69%) with 13% reaching the higher standard.

- In reading 47% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 74%) with 7% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 98.4

- In maths 44% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 71%) with 5% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 98.4

- In grammar, punctuation and spelling 62% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 72%) with 16% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 102

27% of Year 6 children achieved the national standard in reading, writing and maths combined. This compares to 59% nationally.

Progress

- The school's value added score for writing is -0.39

- The school's value added score for reading is -6.52

- The school's value added score for maths is -5.23.
