



Our headline 2018 SATs results for Key Stage 2 were:-

- In writing 80% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 78%) with 7% reaching the higher standard.

- In reading 67% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 75%) with 13% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 102.6

- In maths 63% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 76%) with 7% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 101.6

- In grammar, punctuation and spelling 80% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 78%) with 23% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 105.4

50% of Year 6 children achieved the national standard in reading, writing and maths combined. This compares to 64% nationally

Progress

The Department for Education calculates the progress that each child makes using a scale where 0 is the average rate of progress made nationally by all children. Positive figures demonstrate the cohort has made better than expected progress and negative figures demonstrate progress that is less than expected.

- The school's value added score for writing is -0.82.

- The school's value added score for reading is -1.54.

- The school's value added score for maths is -1.68.
