



Our headline 2016 SATs results for Key Stage 2 were:-

- In reading 56% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 66%) with 3% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 100

- In writing 76% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 74%) with 10% reaching the higher standard.

- In maths 76% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 70%) with 23% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 104

- In grammar, punctuation and spelling 73% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 72%) with 17% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 103

Progress

The Department for Education calculates the progress that each child makes using a scale where 0 is the average rate of progress made nationally by all children. Positive figures demonstrate the cohort has made better than expected progress and negative figures demonstrate progress that is less than expected.

- The school's value added score for reading is +0.8.

- The school's value added score for writing is +1.7.

- The school's value added score for maths is +3.7.
