Once complete, you can discuss the answers together and why these things can't be shared online. The aim is for your child to understand that any personal information shouldn't be shared online. This includes the following from the activity sheet:

your name

a secret

your address

the name of your school

your phone number

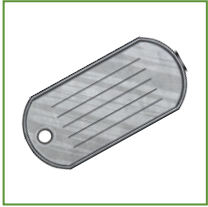
a photo of you or your family

what you have had for lunch



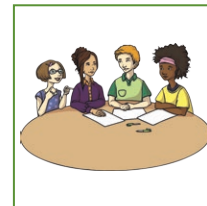
