

Free Online course to support children with attendance difficulties

Define Fine is a team of professionals and parents with lived experience of school attendance difficulties. They are unique as a school attendance support focussed organisation, as in addition to their online group parent peer support and webinars with Q & A sessions, they offer direct 1:1 peer support and advocacy at no cost to parent carers.



The Mental Health Number connects callers to trained professionals, who can provide local support, advice or signposting or advice over the telephone. All of this is available anytime of the day or night, every day of the year. 0800 448 0828 – Lines available 24 hours a day, seven days a week


