



Our headline 2019 SATs results for Key Stage 2 were:-

- In writing 78 % of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 78%) with 17% reaching the higher standard.

- In reading 60% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 73%) with 16% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 101.4

- In maths 69% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 79%) with 12% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 102.7

- In grammar, punctuation and spelling 71% of Year 6 children achieved at least the national standard (Nationally 78%) with 21% reaching the higher standard.

Average scaled score- 103.8

52% of Year 6 children achieved the national standard in reading, writing and maths combined. This compares to 65% nationally.

Progress

- The school's value added score for writing is -0.33

- The school's value added score for reading is -2.40

- The school's value added score for maths is -1.66.
